# **APPLICATION**

Apply **270 Eziwerk Moss & Mould Killer** using a garden spray pack or other suitable applicator to spread evenly over contaminated surfaces. Thoroughly saturate the contaminated surface to ensure that all infestation is fully wetted out with the diluted **270 Eziwerk Moss & Mould Killer**.

For heavy infestations allow approximately 30 days for **270 Eziwerk Moss & Mould Killer** to work. All debris can then be removed by scrubbing or low pressure waterblasting. A further application at a mixing ratio specified under "steriliser" will provide good long-term protection of the surface if it is to remain unpainted.

In all other circumstances follow the mixing ratios and apply evenly over the contaminated surface to provide a surface that can either be left for the dead biological growth to weather away naturally or removed by scrubbing or low pressure waterblasting to ensure a clean, bright surface.
