SUITABILITY

This product has been designed as a general purpose heavy duty cleaner for the removal of fat, grease and oil contamination in advance of the painting process.

DIRECTIONS

This product is supplied as a concentrate to allow for preparation of a solution appropriate for the intended task. Refer to the table to select the mixing ratio most suited to the intended task. This mix can then be applied by physically scrubbing onto the surface in a manner which will generate foam. When completed, remove by hosing down with fresh water. In certain situations where there was originally a heavy contamination of grease and fats, it may be necessary to rinse with hot water and/or carry out the cleaning process twice to ensure that all surfaces have been thoroughly degreased.

If cleaning in preparation for a painting process, allow the surface to dry thoroughly. Sand, prepare and prime as directed.
