#### PHYSICAL PROPERTIES

Drying Time	Touch Dry: 30 minutes -1 hour in ambient conditions
Recoat Time	2 hours at ambient temperatures

#### APPLICATION DATA

Ensure surface temperature is above 10°C before application. \$Value Wall & Ceiling Flat White may be applied by brush, roller or spray. One coat of \$Value Wall & Ceiling Flat White followed by two coats of the desired acrylic topcoat should be applied for best results.

Theoretical Spreading Rate	Approximately 7-9m <sup>2</sup> /litre
Thinners	Thin product sparingly if needed with clean water Clean all equipment immediately after use with clean water

**Previously Painted Ceilings** Clean thoroughly to remove all dirt, stains, loose and flaking paint prior to application.
