SUBSTRATE PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

General Surface Preparation: Surfaces to be painted must be clean with all traces of grease, oil and dirt removed. Remove all loose material including flaking and peeling paint, mould and dust. New plaster must be fully cured before painting. Sand glossy surfaces to a dull finish. If mould or mildew are present, treat affected areas with **A924 Mould Kill X200**, following the directions on the pack. Remove grease and dirt by washing down with liquid sugar soap as per label directions. If wallpaper has been stripped all wallpaper paste should be removed. Fill holes and cracks with a suitable filler. Sand the surface smooth with 150 or 180 grit sandpaper. Remove sanding dust and apply the appropriate preparatory product. When surface is thoroughly dry and properly prepared proceed with painting as per specific instructions, relevant to your substrate, below.

Previously painted surfaces that are sound and prepared as above: Apply 2 coats of C517 Ultrasmooth.

Bare timber & MDF: Sand dressed timber to break the "mill glaze" for proper penetration and adhesion. Prime with one coat of **AB28 Duratrade Acrylic Primer Undercoat** followed by 2 coats of **C517 Ultrasmooth**.

<u>Bare Gib®</u>: Seal with one coat of C513 Duratrade Easysand or AB29 Duratrade Acrylic Drywall Sealer followed by 2 coats of C517 Ultrasmooth.

<u>Sunburned or skim coated Gib®</u>: Seal with one coat of A200 Duralon Alkyd Pigmented Sealer followed by 2 coats of C517 Ultrasmooth.

Constraints

Do not apply when temperature is below 5°C or humidity is greater than 85%.

Not recommended for use in kitchens, bathrooms and laundries. In these areas use either A322 Duralon Kitchen &

Bathroom Pearl Finish, A306 Imperion Satin Water Based Enamel or AB36 Duratrade Semi Gloss Enamel.

RECOMMENDED APPLICATION METHODS AND TECHNIQUES

Apply in full, even coats.

Thin, if required for ease of application in hot conditions or on very porous substrates, with up to 10% water.

Minimum Surface Temperature:	5°C
Maximum Relative Humidity:	85%
Temperature Range:	5°C - 35°C
Suitable Application Methods:	Brush, Roller, Airless Spray
Thinners:	Water
Cleaning Solvent:	Water
Max. Volume Thinners:	10%
Nozzle Orifice:	11–15 Thou
Fan Angle:	30°-50°
Nozzle Pressure:	1800 – 2500psi

DRYING CHARACTERISTICS

All figures quoted are at 20°C and 65% relative humidity.

Drying will take longer at lower temperatures and/or at higher relative humidity.

Do not paint when temperature of surface is below 5°C, above 35°C or when humidity is above 85%.

Touch Dry;	30 minutes
Recoat:	2 hours
Full Cure:	7 days

MAINTENANCE OF PAINT FINISHES

After one week, **C517 Ultrasmooth** will reach its full stain resistance (tinted colours require up to 2 weeks). Cleaning with a non abrasive cleaner such as Ajax Spray 'n' Wipe[™] and a damp cloth is recommended.
